GOSPEL

JOHN 2:1-11



On the third day there was a wedding in Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding. When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." (And) Jesus said to her, "Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come." His

mother said to the servers, "Do whatever he tells you." Now there were six stone water jars there for Jewish ceremonial washings, each holding twenty to thirty gallons. Jesus told them, "Fill the jars with water." So they filled them to the brim. Then he told them, "Draw some out now and take it to the headwaiter." So they took it. And

when the headwaiter tasted the water that had become wine. without knowing where it came from (although the servers who had drawn the water knew), the headwaiter called the bridegroom and said to him, "Everyone serves good wine first, and then when people have drunk freely, an inferior one; but you have kept the good wine until now." Jesus did this as the beginning of his signs in Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory, and his disciples began to believe in him. This is the Truth. Peace be with you.

WE WELCOME OUR SHEPARD, BISHOP GREGORY

MANSOUR to Saint Maron to celebrate our great feast. Sayednya just returned from spending three weeks in Lebanon working with the Patriarch and his brother Bishops on projects for the universal church.

For those new to our parish, Bishop Gregory John Mansour graduated from Catholic University of America and the Gregorian University in Rome with Degrees in Theology and Spirituality, and was ordained to the Priesthood in 1982.

Sayednya served as Pastor in Uniontown, PA, then as Vicar General, Chancellor and Financial Officer of the new Maronite Eparchy in Los Angeles, and studied at U.C.L.A. with special emphasis on Islamic Studies. After his time in Los Angeles, he served in St. Louis as Vicar General and Cathedral Rector, and taught Spiritual Theology at Kenrick-Glennon Seminary.

In 2004, Pope John Paul II named him Bishop of the Eparchy of Saint Maron of Brooklyn. He has served on the USCCB's Pro Life, Family Life, Catechesis and Evangelization Committees, and is presently Co-Chair of the Oriental Orthodox-Catholic Dialogue.

He has served on the Board of Trustees for The Catholic University of America, was Board Chair of Catholic Relief Services, and presently serves on the Boards of Aid to the Church in Need, Caritas Lebanon, In Defense of Christians, and is a member of the Maronite Synod of Bishops in Lebanon.

Thank you Sayednya for being with us today. We continue to pray for you and our Eparchy. We are excited to hear about your trip to Lebanon and look forward to praying with you this weekend. A warm welcome to Torrington!!

EPISTLE

ISAIAH 55: 1+6-13

All you who are thirsty, come to the water! You who have no money, come, buy grain and eat; Come, buy grain without money, wine and milk without cost! Seek the LORD while he may be found, call upon him while he is near. Let the wicked forsake their way, and sinners their thoughts; Let them turn to the LORD to find mercy; to our God, who is generous in forgiving. For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways—oracle of the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, my thoughts higher than your thoughts. Yet just as from the heavens the rain and snow come down And do not return there till they have watered the earth, making it fertile and fruitful, Giving seed to the one who sows and bread to the one who eats. So shall my word be that goes forth from my mouth; It shall not return to me empty, but shall do what pleases me, achieving the end for which I sent it. My Dear Friends:

St. Maron longed for a very deep union with God. To find this, he gave up all worldly attachments and spent his days on a mountain, out in the open, in prayer. His self-discipline, fasting, and meditation inspired many people to come to him for both spiritual guidance and physical healing. His fame spread and more and more people came to see him. Some of them built a monastery near his tent on the mountain. Soon there were hundreds of monks gathered around St. Maron, learning from and imitating him, passing down his wisdom and staying faithful to the church during the many persecutions down through the years. Our own Maronite church sprang from these seeds.

God gave St. Maron the grace to seek Him in everything and St. Maron embraced that desire. St. Maron only intended to love God, not start a community. He could not know that this faithful branch of the church would endure through the ages, to this day, here in Torrington.

What is it that God is asking us to do? Giving us the grace to do? Are we doing it? We don't know how God intends to use our faithfulness; we only know that God wants us to be faithful to His inspirations.

I pray that God will bless all of you in a special way this week.
