MATTHEW 25:14-30



"It will be as when a man who was going on a journey called in his servants and entrusted his possessions to them. SAINT OF THE WEEK

We celebrate the feast of a great martyr on October 20 – St. Artemius, also known as St. Shalita in the Maronite calendar. St. Artemius, who died in the year 363 is venerated in both the eastern and the western churches.

The saint was appointed military Governor of Egypt by Emperor Constantine the Great. After Constantine's death, the new Emperor, Julian the Apostate restored paganism as the official religion of the Roman empire, beginning a new persecution of the Christians. At the same time, he also started a war with Persia. Artemius was

ordered to come to Antioch with the military forces under his command to support the Emperor. He arrived just in time to see Julian publicly torture and execute

two pious Christians, Eugenius and Macarius. St Artemius immediately, fearlessly and publicly rebuked the Emperor with these words: Why do you so cruelly torture these holy men? Do not forget that you also are a man and that it was God who allowed you to be Emperor. Take care, for Satan, who asked permission to tempt Job, may have requested leave to use you against us, in order to sow tare amid the wheat of Christ. But his scheme will be futile because he no longer has the power he had of old. Since Christ came and was raised on the Cross, Satan's pride and power were defeated. Do not have illusions, O Emperor! In following your love of Satan, do not persecute the Christians protected by God. The power of Christ is invincible.

This speech enraged the emperor who had Artemius thrown into prison. The next day, Artemius was brought before Julian, and promised even higher imperial office if he would renounce Christ and worship the statues of the pagan gods. When Artemius refused, he was tortured and finally beheaded.

St. Artemius please pray for us that we might always stand up publicly for the truth as you did.

GALATIANS 6:1-10

Brothers, even if a person is caught in some transgression, you who are spiritual should correct that one in a gentle spirit, looking to yourself, so that you also may not be tempted. Bear one another's burdens, and so you will fulfill the law of Christ. For if anyone thinks he is something when he is nothing, he is deluding himself. Each one must examine his own work, and then he will have reason to boast with regard to himself alone, and not with regard to someone else; for each will bear his own load. One who is being instructed in the word should share all good things with his instructor. Make no mistake: God is not mocked, for a person will reap only what he sows, because the one who sows for his flesh will reap corruption from the flesh, but the one who sows for the spirit will reap eternal life from the spirit. Let us not grow tired of doing good, for in due time we shall reap our harvest, if we do not give up. So then, while we have the opportunity, let us do good to all, but especially to those who belong to the family of the faith.
