# **EPISTLE**

1 THESSALONIANS 5:1-11

Concerning times and seasons, brothers, you have no need for anything to be written to you. For you yourselves know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief at night. When people are saying, "Peace and security," then sudden disaster comes upon them, like labor pains upon a pregnant woman, and they will not escape. But you, brothers, are not in darkness, for that day to overtake you like a thief. For all of you are children of the light and children of the day. We are not of the night or of darkness. Therefore, let us not sleep as the rest do, but let us stay alert and sober. Those who sleep go to sleep at night, and those who are drunk get drunk at night. But since we are of the day, let us be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love and the helmet that is hope for salvation. For God did not destine us for wrath, but to gain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us, so that whether we are awake or asleep we may live together with him. Therefore, encourage one another and build one another up, as indeed you do.



# My Dear Friends:

I mentioned last week that October is traditionally called the Month of the Rosary because the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated on October 7. The reason we have this feast on October 7 is that this is the anniversary of the great Christian victory at Lepanto.

In 1571 the Holy League, a coalition of Spanish, Italian and French forces fought the much larger Muslim Ottoman Turk forces in a naval battle in the Gulf of Patras, and, to the amazement of the world, won. It was the first Christian victory over the Ottomans in hundreds of years; it was fought both to end Ottoman raiding around the Mediterranean for Christian slaves and to stop the Turks from marching on Italy.

Before the battle, every Holy League soldier and sailor was given a Rosary which they all prayed together before the battle. The decisive victory of the much smaller Holy League has always been attributed to the Blessed Mother's intercession – hence the feast.

All the saints testify to the power of the Rosary. Should you ever doubt it, remember Lepanto!
