GOSPEL

MATTHEW 24:23-31



If anyone says to you then, 'Look, here is the Messiah!' or, 'There he is!' do not believe it. False messiahs and false prophets will arise, and they will perform signs and wonders so great as to deceive, if that were possible, even the elect. Behold, I have told it to you beforehand. My Dear Friends:

October is traditionally called the Month of the Rosary, primarily because the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated on October 7. It is a good month to start praying the Rosary if you don't already.

The majority of the events described in the Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful and Glorious mysteries of the Rosary are found in Scripture. The few that aren't come from church Tradition – those stories that were never written down, but instead, passed along orally from generation to generation. When we pray the Rosary we are meditating deeply on Christ's joys, sacrifices, sufferings and glorious miracles. As we keep the events of His life in front of us, we can't help coming closer and closer to Him.

The two main prayers of the Rosary – the Our Father and the Hail Mary – come from Scripture. The words of the Our Father are those Christ taught His disciples to pray in Matthew 6:9–13. The Hail Mary also comes straight from the Bible. The first part, "Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with thee," comes from Luke 1:28, and the second, "Blessed art thou amongst women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb," is found in Luke 1:42. In the last part of the Hail Mary we ask Mary to intercede for us, just as we might ask a family member or friend to pray for us.

Sometimes it's hard to start praying the whole Rosary at once. When you are not used to it, it seems like a lot. If that's the case, then you can start slowly - just pray one of the mysteries at first and slowly work your way up.
