#### **EDISTLE**

**GALATIANS 4:21-5:1** 

Tell me, you who desire to be subject to the law, will you not listen to the law? For it is written that Abraham had two sons, one by a slave woman and the other by a free woman. One, the child of the slave, was born according to the flesh; the other, the child of the free woman, was born through the promise. Now this is an allegory: these women are two covenants. One woman, in fact, is Hagar, from Mount Sinai, bearing children for slavery. Now Hagar is Mount Sinai in Arabia and corresponds to the present Jerusalem, for she is in slavery with her children. But the other woman corresponds to the Jerusalem above; she is free, and she is our mother. For it is written, "Rejoice, you childless one, you who bear no children, burst into song and shout, you who endure no birth pangs; for the children of the desolate woman are more numerous than the children of the one who is married." Now you, my friends, are children of the promise, like Isaac. But just as at that time the child who was born according to the flesh persecuted the child who was born according to the Spirit, so it is now also. But what does the scripture say? "Drive out the slave and her child; for the child of the slave will not share the inheritance with the child of the free woman." So then, friends, we are children, not of the slave but of the free woman. For freedom Christ has set us free. Stand firm, therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery. Praise be to God always!

all these things were talked about throughout the entire hill country of Judea. All who heard them pondered them and said, "What then will this child become?" For, indeed, the hand of the Lord was with him. This is the truth. Peace be with you.





My Dear Friends:

In the Acts of the Apostles, chapter 16 Paul and Silas continue their missionary journey, guided by the Holy Spirit. They visit Philippi, and convert Lydia, a seller of purple cloth: "A woman named Lydia, a dealer in purple cloth, from the city of Thyatira, a worshiper of God, listened, and the Lord opened her heart to pay attention to what Paul was saying." (16:14). Moreover, they help a slave girl possessed by a spirit, freeing her in Jesus' name. Later, Paul and Silas are arrested, beaten, and imprisoned for their faith, but they pray and sing hymns, and an earthquake miraculously opens the prison doors: "About midnight, while Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God as the prisoners listened, there was suddenly such a severe earthquake that the foundations of the jail shook; all the doors flew open, and the chains of all were pulled loose." (16:25-26).

Saint Luke reminds us in this chapter that God guides us in every step of our lives.

This week my question for you is: who was the last person who made you laugh?

#### THE OLD TESTAMENT: BARUCH

The prophet Baruch was the faithful scribe and companion of the prophet Jeremiah. He reminds us that only God saves. He tells us to trust in God even in suffering. He teaches us to learn the true wisdom in God's word: "Learn where prudence is, where strength, where understanding; That you may know also where are length of days, and life, where light of the eyes, and peace." (Baruch 3:14). He invites us to put our hope in God who will lead us back to live in happiness: "For God is leading Israel in joy by the light of his glory, with his mercy and justice for company." (Baruch 5:9)

The prophet Baruch reminds us that in times of trials, we must place our trust not in idols or worldly powers, but in the living God who leads his people with mercy and light. His words prepare us for Jesus Christ, the true wisdom and the light of the world.


