The theme of this week's Gospel is: When was the last time I said to someone, "you are not alone; I am with you." Today, the Gospel reminds me that God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit say exactly the same thing to me.

# THE GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT BY FR. NICOLAS EL-KADA

The Gifts of the Holy Spirit are seven supernatural gifts bestowed upon the faithful, especially at Baptism and Confirmation, to make them docile to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. Rooted in Isaiah 11:2–3 and affirmed in the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC §1830–1831), these gifts help the Christian live a holy life and grow in virtue. The gifts are: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. While several great Catholic theologians and saints have written deeply about the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit, St. Thomas Aquinas' interpretation of the gifts, the virtues they perfect and their meaning stands out as comprehensive and influential:

# **EPISTLE**

ROMANS 11:25-36

I do not want you to be unaware of this mystery, brothers, so that you will not become wise (in) your own estimation: a hardening has come upon Israel in part, until the full number of the Gentiles comes in, and thus all Israel will be saved, as it is written: "The deliverer will come out of Zion, he will turn away godlessness from Jacob; and this is my covenant with them when I take away their sins." In respect to the gospel, they are enemies on your account; but in respect to election, they are beloved because of the patriarchs. For the gifts and the call of God are irrevocable. Just as you once disobeyed God but have now received mercy because of their disobedience, so they have now disobeyed in order that, by virtue of the mercy shown to you, they too may (now) receive mercy. For God delivered all to disobedience, that he might have mercy upon all. Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How inscrutable are his judgments and how unsearchable his ways! "For who has known the mind of the Lord or who has been his counselor?" "Or who has given him anything that he may be repaid?" For from him and through him and for him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen.

**Wisdom** perfects *Charity (love of God)* and enables us to judge all things by divine standards and delight in God above all.

**Understanding** perfects *Faith* and gives us deep insight into divine truths – not just belief, but clarity.

**Counsel** perfects *Prudence* and helps us listen to the Holy Spirit in practical choices, especially in difficult or unclear situations.

**Fortitude** perfects *Courage* and gives spiritual strength to endure hardships for the sake of the Gospel.

**Knowledge** perfects *Faith and Justice* helping us to see created things as they relate to God thereby avoiding misuse and idolatry.

**Piety** perfects *Justice* (toward God and others). This fosters love for God as Father as well as devotion to His Church and people.

**Fear of the Lord** perfects *Hope and Humility*, keeping us in reverence and awe, which in turn helps us avoid sin, not just from fear of hell, but from love of God.

What I would like you to remember about our Divine Liturgy this week is this: The Divine Liturgy brings newness because it is built on the person of Christ who is the cornerstone of the Liturgy. The Bible says in Revelation, chapter 21, verse 5: The one who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new."

I would also like to draw your attention to the beautiful reflection on the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit written by Fr. Nicolas El-Kada. It starts on page one and continues below. It is so appropriate in this season of Pentecost.

# PROVERBS CHAPTER 14:1-9

- 1 The wise woman builds her house, but the foolish tears it down with her own hands.
- Those who walk uprightly fear the Lord, but one who is devious in conduct despises him.
- 3 The talk of fools is a rod for their backs, but the lips of the wise preserve them.
- Where there are no oxen, there is no grain; abundant crops come by the strength of the ox.
- A faithful witness does not lie, but a false witness breathes out lies.
- 6 A scoffer seeks wisdom in vain, but knowledge is easy for one who understands.
- 7 Leave the presence of a fool, for there you do not find words of knowledge.
- 8 It is the wisdom of the clever to understand where they go, but the folly of fools misleads.
- 9 Fools mock at the guilt offering, but the upright enjoy God's favor.

The Gifts of the Holy Spirit are deeply rooted in the spirituality of St. Maron, the father of the Maronite Church. Living a life of prayer, asceticism, and deep union with God, St. Maron embodied the wisdom, fortitude, and piety that flow from the Spirit. His spirituality teaches us that the Holy Spirit is not merely a distant power, but a personal presence who transforms the heart, renews the mind, and animates every act of love and service. In the silence of the mountain and the simplicity of monastic life, the seven gifts took flesh and bore fruit. Today, the Maronite tradition continues to live out this legacy, calling each believer to be a vessel of the Spirit's grace, rooted in contemplation, strengthened by the Eucharist, and sent forth in joyful mission.
