JOHN 2:1-11



On the third day there was a wedding in Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding. When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." (And) Jesus said to her, "Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come." His

mother said to the servers, "Do whatever he tells you." Now there

were six stone water jars there for Jewish ceremonial washings, each holding twenty to thirty gallons. Jesus told them, "Fill the jars with water." So they filled them to the brim. Then he told them, "Draw some out now and take it to the headwaiter." So they took it. And when the headwaiter tasted the water that had become wine. without knowing where it came from (although the servers who had drawn the water knew), the headwaiter called the bridegroom and said to him, "Everyone serves good wine first, and then when people have drunk freely, an inferior one; but you have kept the good wine until

EDISTLE

ROMANS 14:14-23

I know and am convinced in the Lord Jesus that nothing is unclean in itself; still, it is unclean for someone who thinks it unclean. If your brother is being hurt by what you eat, your conduct is no longer in accord with love. Do not because of your food destroy him for whom Christ died. So do not let your good be reviled. For the kingdom of God is not a matter of food and drink, but of righteousness, peace, and joy in the holy Spirit; whoever serves Christ in this way is pleasing to God and approved by others. Let us then pursue what leads to peace and to building up one another. For the sake of food, do not destroy the work of God. Everything is indeed clean, but it is wrong for anyone to become a stumbling block by eating; it is good not to eat meat or drink wine or do anything that causes your brother to stumble. Keep the faith (that) you have to yourself in the presence of God; blessed is the one who does not condemn himself for what he approves. But whoever has doubts is condemned if he eats, because this is not from faith; for whatever is not from faith is sin. Praise be to God always.

My Dear Friends:

This month our prayer is for our children and our grandchildren. You will find it to the left; and now to continue some more teachings about our beautiful Maronite Divine Liturgy.

In the book of Genesis the first act of creation is the separation of light from darkness. In the final act in Genesis, God gives life to man, making him in His image and likeness. The Bible begins with the creation of light in Genesis and it ends in the book of Revelation by presenting the light of the Parousia (the second coming of Christ.) Remember, in John 8:12, Jesus said, *I am the light of the world*.

Patriarch Doueihi teaches that lighting the candles before the Liturgy reminds us that we, too, are to light the lamps of our minds, separating the light from what is darkness, meaning the sinful acts of darkness that lead us to death, and be the light that leads us to life. The prayer of light reflects our creation in the state of holiness and light. It reminds us that Christ is the Light which came to enlighten us and save us from the darkness. Light becomes connected with life, just as darkness is connected to death, or whatever deprives people from happiness.

Light and life, like Himself, are gifts from God to the world. They are not to be accepted passively. Rather, they represent a call to action for every human for a transformation, for a transfiguration (John 9).

I hope that you and your families have a blessed week ahead as we now enter into Great Lent.
