




The Judgement of the Nations

HEBREWS 12:18-24

Brothers and Sisters:

You have not come to something that can be touched, a blazing fire, and darkness, and gloom, and a tempest, and the sound of a trumpet, and a voice whose words made the hearers beg that not another word be spoken to them. (For they could not endure the order that was given, "If even an animal touches the mountain, it shall be stoned to death." Indeed, so terrifying was the sight that Moses said, "I tremble with fear.") But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to innumerable angels in festal gathering, and to the assembly of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, and to God the judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous made perfect, and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel. Praise be to God always!

'Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me.' Then he will say to those at his left hand, 'You that are accursed, depart from me into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels; for I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me nothing to drink, I was a stranger and you did not welcome me, naked and you did not give me clothing, sick and in prison and you did not visit me.' Then they also will answer, 'Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not take care of you?' Then he will answer them, 'Truly I tell you, just as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to me.' And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life." This is the truth. Peace be with you.

My Dear Friends:

Before I continue with the Acts of the Apostles, I would like to ask for your help. I would like to create a group of people who would visit the elderly with me at the nursing homes once each month. This is such a rewarding activity and one way of practicing the works of mercy Jesus mentions in this week's gospel. Please give this some thought and prayer and if you are interested please see me after Liturgy or give me a call. Thank you very kindly for your consideration of this request.

Chapter 24 in the Acts of the Apostles describes Saint Paul standing on trial before the Roman governor Felix. The Jewish leaders accuse him of causing trouble and profaning the Temple. But Paul calmly defends himself saying he serves the God of his fathers with a clear conscience and believes in the resurrection of the just and the unjust. He speaks honestly about justice, self-control, and the coming judgment, which makes Felix uneasy. Though convinced of Paul's innocence, Felix keeps him imprisoned, hoping for a bribe and trying to please the authorities. The chapter shows Paul as a fearless witness: even in chains, he turns a courtroom into a place of preaching.

My question for you this week is: When was the last time you invited God into the decisions of your life?

THE OLD TESTAMENT: JOSHUA

The book of Joshua tells the story of how God leads Israel into the Promised Land after the death of Moses. Joshua, filled with courage and obedience, guides the people across the Jordan River, conquers cities like Jericho, and helps the tribes settle in their inheritance. The book shows that victory does not come from strength alone but from faithful trust in God's promises. Again and again, Israel succeeds when they listen to the Lord and struggles when they rely only on themselves. Joshua ends by calling the people to choose fidelity: "As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord." (Joshua 24:15).

Each year the USCCB designates the observance of National Marriage Week during February 7-14, and World Marriage Day this year on Sunday February 8. The theme selected for 2026 is: "Man and Woman He Created Them: Together with Purpose."
